

# GREEN SCENE

The month of August brought a brutal stretch of temperatures, humidity, and a day of flash flooding for the Purchase Area. We hope that this month lets the turf on the course enjoy some cooler and milder weather. Every August we start charting cooling degree days to know when to spray for bermudagrass in the fairways. Our target is 10 CDD, and we should be in the window to spray early this month.

As I write this article, the greens are scheduled to be aerated, weather pending, on Monday, August 30th. With hurricane Ida scheduled to impact our area early next week, I hope that the process is completed, and the greens are on their way to recovery. A 3/8" coring tine will be used and a pretty aggressive verticutting. The goal in coring and verticutting is to eliminate as much organic matter as possible, while providing channels for the bentgrass seed to find a surface slit to enhance germination. We have been introducing 007 bentgrass to the greens a couple times a year, and follow a University tested interseeding program. The interseeding program we use has been shown to introduce this new variety into existing stands of Penncross bentgrass. Over time, the greens should start to take on the growth characteristics of the 007. Those include a finer textured and deeper, more fibrous root system. The 007 bentgrass variety likes temperatures that are hotter than Penncross bentgrass. So, the more of the newer variety we can establish in our greens, the better surfaces we will have in the summer months. Also, an added benefit to overseeding at fall aerification is the

process wards off the poa seed bank that exists in the green profiles. Less poa means we will have better putting quality in the future.

September as always is the transition month from summer to fall, and this will be a busy month, as we are scheduled to begin resurfacing the cart paths on September 14<sup>th</sup>. Completing this project is really going to change the aesthetics to the course and provide safer walking and riding for all. Green Tee Golf will be returning this week to finish some drainage that affects the paving process and begin stripping sod around the paths for paving. Once Smith Contracting finishes the paving process, Green Tee will then begin to add soil and recontour the ground next to the paths. This process will ensure water makes its way to the new installed drainage. Once the soil is recontoured, they will resod these areas. Additionally, we will improve the drainage in 1, 7, and 16 fairways and add some length to holes 1, 4, 13 and 16. On the agronomic front, the warm season turf will soon start to slow in growth due to photoperiod being reduced and cooler nights. The trees will soon start getting ready for winter by changing color and shedding leaves. Additionally, we have ordered the ryegrass for our fall overseeding of the rough. We will start planting the seed as soon as we can. The process takes us about 3-4 weeks to complete. Other items on the agenda include, adding additional soil to the drainage ditch berm between 4 and 7 tees, spraying the warm season turf for zoysia patch and Bermuda encroachment, a preemergent for poa and winter annual weeds will be applied as well.


