

GREEN SCENE


Fall has arrived early in the Western Kentucky region. The temperatures have been October-like since the last part of September, and these temperatures have been welcomed by the turf staff. The warm season turfs have started to slow in growth, and we have been able to finally get the vertical growth of the rough under control. Precipitation has been hit or miss over the past couple weeks and we seem to be entering very dry conditions.

Fall greens aerification went well. The greens healed quickly and the overseeded bentgrass is developing nicely. We are still applying nutrients and topdressing to encourage the new bentgrass seedlings to develop as much as possible, until the temperatures dictate otherwise. Root-feeding fertilization is important in the fall to lay the foundation for next years root system on the greens. Even when temperatures have gotten cold in late fall and we are not cutting much grass or not yielding a lot of clippings in our mower baskets, the roots are still growing almost up to the time the ground freezes. We have applied our fall growth regulator for poa. This application will dramatically slow the vertical growth of all grasses in the greens and give the bentgrass the competitive



advantage over the poa. An added benefit is the greens should get smooth and have excellent speed.

October is a transition month in the turf care center operations. Mowing of the tees and fairways gets less frequent and that labor is used to accomplish projects and battle the abundance of leaves that fall on property. The tees, collars, and fairways will receive a last liquid fertilizer application and herbicide and fungicide treatment to prepare them for winter dormancy. The process of seeding rough is underway and will occupy most of the month. The overseeded ryegrass should provide density and aesthetic value to the course in a short period of time. The resurfacing of the cart paths is ongoing, with the back 9 being completed. The plan is for the resurfacing to be finished by the first full week of this month. Green Tee is doing a fantastic job on the shouldering of the cart paths. They are moving right along and should be laying sod soon. Additionally, Green Tee will be improving drainage on 1, 7, and 16 fairways, and adding width to the concrete paths at 1 and 10 tees. Tee expansion on 1, 4, and the combo tee at 13/16 will be underway soon. In short, the construction process is moving along and when finished these improvements will further enhance our great Club!
